Dr. Babatope serves in leadership roles as the Training director of the Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Fellowship Program and the Executive Director, Senate Bill 11 – Texas Child Mental Health Consortium (TCMHCC) service programs at the Louis A. Faillace, MD, Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at McGovern Medical School at UTHealth. She is the Director of the autism spectrum disorders and Neurodevelopmental lifespan specialty clinic and a telemedicine-based provider with the UTHealth Houston Child Psychiatry Access Network (CPAN) and Perinatal Psychiatry Access Network (PeriPAN) programs, amongst other clinical supervisory roles.

Dr. Babatope's ability to provide experiential learning has led to her being awarded the 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 Dean's Teaching Excellence Awards for four consecutive years and being inducted into the McGovern Medical School Academy of Master Educators. She was selected amongst several medical practitioners in the state of Texas to be a 2023-2024 Texas Medical Association Leadership College (TMALC) Scholar, and she currently serves as AADPRT's Region 5 Child Psychiatry Subspecialty Representative and a Presidential Appointee to the Executive Council.
