Ana Ozdoba, MD, is Director of the Psychiatry Residency Training Program at Montefiore Medical Center and Assistant Professor of Albert Einstein College of Medicine in the Bronx, New York. She completed her Psychiatry training in 2007 at Montefiore Medical Center, where she continued her career as an Attending in the Adult Outpatient Psychiatry Department. Dr. Ozdoba has had different leadership and administrative roles, including Medical Director of the Adult Outpatient Psychiatry Clinic at the Moses Campus of Montefiore, Departmental Director of Quality Improvement and Chair and Founder of the Department of Psychiatry's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee. Dr. Ozdoba has clinical experience as an outpatient psychiatrist, providing psychotherapy and psychopharmacological treatment to the Spanish Speaking community of the Bronx. She has experience in program development and management, improving the quality and efficiency of psychiatric care, and incorporating systemic changes to target patient safety. Dr. Ozdoba has been a leader in Quality Improvement Projects related to creating a Structural Competency/Humility Curriculum and Improving Psychiatric Handoffs, among other topics. She teaches in the resident curriculum on Supportive and Psychodynamic Psychotherapy, the Psychiatric Interview, Structural Competency, Leadership, Collaborative Care, and Coping with Patient Suicide. Dr. Ozdoba is the New York Regional Representative for the American Association of Directors of Residency Training Association (2020-23) and an active member of its Diversity and Inclusion Committee. She has done multiple presentations at National Conferences, including the American Psychiatric Association, Society for the Study of Psychiatry and Culture, and the American Association of Directors of Residency Training.
