The Nominating Committee requests the following information via this form one-week prior to your interview date:

- An updated CV
- A *one-page* personal statement describing your:
 - Vision, goals, and reasons for wanting to help lead AADPRT
 - Your AADPRT engagement and service to date (e.g., # of workshops, project leads, chair positions, membership on committees/caucus/taskforces, other)
 - o Relevant leadership experience outside of AADPRT
 - Short and long-term career goals

Click here to schedule your 30-minute interview. At least three members of the Nominating Committee will conduct the interview via Zoom (members listed below). You will be asked the following questions:

- 1. What are your vision, goals, and rationale for wanting to help lead AADPRT?
- 2. What have you contributed to, or gained from, your involvement in AADPRT?
- 3. Of all of your leadership experiences in or out of AADPRT, what are you most proud of and why?
- 4. How are you going to manage the workload with your concurrent other commitments, including your 'day' job?
- 5. How will you advance diversity and equity in AADPRT?

Interviews will be recorded such that all members are able to review the interview.

The Nominating Committee will use a rubric in evaluating each nominee which includes the following factors:

- 1. Vision for AADPRT
- 2. AADPRT experience and service
- 3. Potential to advance equity
- 4. Capacity for leadership
- 5. Ability to commit to the time requirements
