## Brian Gin, MD, PhD

Dr. Gin is an Associate Clinical Professor in the Department of Pediatrics at the School of Medicine, University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). He serves as the Associate Clerkship Director for Pediatrics and the Associate Program Director for the Pediatric Hospital Medicine Fellowship. Dr. Gin received his MA in Education (item response theory for dyadic measures) and his PhD in Chemistry (computational modeling of protein evolution) from UC Berkeley. He received his medical training at UCSF, where he also completed a residency in Pediatrics and a fellowship in Pediatric Hospital Medicine (learner perspectives of supervisor trust). He is currently a doctoral student in the UCSF-University Medical Center Utrecht program in Health Professions Education. His research focuses on fusing traditional and artificial intelligence (AI) methods to explore how trainees and supervisors develop trust in each other – and more recently, trust in AI.
